Supply Chain Design: This section addresses the concepts and strategies used for developing a supply chain strategy that aligns with business goals and corporate strategy, basic strategy tools, and techniques for implementation. It includes designing a supply chain for the flow of product, information and cash, the use of the SCOR[®] model, project management, and information technology.

2. Supply Chain Planning and Execution: This section addresses the processes required to supply chain partners, reverse logistics procure and deliver goods and services, including the scheduling and logistics of executing the plan. It includes the management of demand and supply, relationship with, and waste management.

3. Supply Chain Improvement and Best Practices: This section covers managing and balancing supply and demand through measuring, analyzing, and improving supply chain processes. It addresses compliance with standards and regulations, the importance of sustainable best practices and social responsibility, and the assessment and mitigation of risk within the supply chain.
